Tourist Visa to Japan Checklist

- Arrange your documents in the order according to the checklist.
- All documents should be printed or photocopied on A4-sized paper.
- Separate all the application documents for different applicants into individual sets.
- NO staples/pins/paper clips should be used on documents.

DOCUMENTS:
Visa application form completed, printed out and signed by hand.
Original passport with at least 6 months validity beyond the validity of the visa.
Passport-size colour photograph – can be arranged in our office.
Copy of Identity card issued by Singapore Government (front and back).
Printout of the validity and expiry status of a pass which can be obtained with a free SGWorkPass app (available on App Store and Google Play).
A certificate of employment from the applicant's employer or a Business Registration Profile from ACRA.
Bank statements showing the transactions for the last 2 months. The minimum amount required for a visa application is 3,000 SGD.
If an applicant is a retiree, unemployed, homemaker, student or minor: - Letter of sponsorship Proof of relationship (copy of a marriage/birth certificate) Copy of the last month's bank statement, copy of their passport and a residence card.
If there are multiple applicants, a list of visa applicants.
A daily itinerary in Japan.
For the multiple-entry visa, a Multiple entry request form.
For the multiple-entry visa, a copy of previous visas .
Authorisation letter.
Completed and signed Global Singapore visa order form

^{*} For Russian and other CIS passport holders, 2 completed application forms and 2 photographs are required.
