## Family Visa (Q2) to China Checklist

- Once you filled in the online form, please, email it to us so we could make an appointment with the Chinese Visa Processing Centre.
- If you are aged between 14 and 70, you will have to submit fingerprints at the China Visa Application Service Centre unless you have already submitted your biometrics in the last 5 years and have not renewed your passport since. We will provide instructions upon submission.
- All documents should be printed or photocopied on A4-sized paper.
- Separate all the application documents for different applicants into individual sets.
- If either of the applicant's parents is a Chinese national, they will need to apply directly at the Chinese embassy.

	Online visa application form completed, printed out and signed on first and last pages.
	Original passport.
	Colour copy of passport.
	Copy of Identity card issued by Singapore Government (front and back).
	Printout of the <b>validity</b> and expiry status of a pass which can be obtained with a free SGWorkPass app (available on App Store and Google Play).
	Passport-size <b>photograph</b> in a digital format (for completing the online form) and on paper (for affixing to the printed out form)
	Copy of <b>previous visas</b> to China if they were stamped in a different/old passport.
	Foreign passport holders who were born in China (inclusive of Hong Kong, Taiwan, and Macao) or once a Chinese citizen, have to provide <b>one</b> of the following documents:
•	<ul> <li>Crossed-out Chinese passport (original and a photocopy of the front page).</li> <li>Copy of each of your recent Chinese visas and a front page of the passport.</li> <li>Copy of a birth certificate and a notarisation.</li> <li>Copy of a crossed-out identity card or a registered residence booklet.</li> <li>For applicants, who are former Chinese citizens and are applying for a Chinese visa for the first time, please provide the crossed-out Chinese passport (original and a photocopy of the front page).</li> </ul>
	If you are applying for a Chinese visa for the first time, you should provide the last Chinese passport held and a photocopy of its data page.
	An <b>invitation letter</b> issued by a Chinese citizen or a foreign citizen with a Chinese permanent residence permit who lives in China. The invitation letter should contain:
	<ul> <li>Information on the applicant (full name, gender, date of birth, etc.).</li> <li>Information on the visit (purpose of visit, arrival and departure dates, place(s) to be visited, relations between the applicant and the inviting individual, financial source for expenditures).</li> </ul>

- Information on the inviting individual (name, contact number, address, signature etc.).
Photocopy of <b>Chinese ID</b> or <b>foreign passport</b> and permanent residence permit of the inviting individual.
Applicants are required to provide photocopy of <b>certification</b> (marriage certificate, birth certificate or notarized certification of kinship) showing the relationship of family members between the applicants and inviting parties.
