

# Family Visa (Q2) to China Checklist

- Once you filled in the online form, please, email it to us so we could make an appointment with the Chinese Visa Processing Centre.
- If you are aged between 14 and 70, you will have to submit fingerprints at the China Visa Application Service Centre unless you have already submitted your biometrics in the last 5 years and have not renewed your passport since. We will provide instructions upon submission.
- All documents should be printed or photocopied on A4-sized paper.
- Separate all the application documents for different applicants into individual sets.
- If either of the applicant's parents is a Chinese national, they will need to apply directly at the Chinese embassy.

<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>Online visa application</b> form completed, printed out and signed on first and last pages.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Original <b>passport</b> .
<input type="checkbox"/>	Colour <b>copy of passport</b> .
<input type="checkbox"/>	Copy of <b>Identity card</b> issued by Singapore Government (front and back).
<input type="checkbox"/>	Printout of the <b>validity</b> and expiry status of a pass which can be obtained with a free SGWorkPass app (available on App Store and Google Play).
<input type="checkbox"/>	Passport-size <b>photograph</b> in a digital format (for completing the online form) and on paper (for affixing to the printed out form)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Copy of <b>previous visas</b> to China if they were stamped in a different/old passport.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Foreign passport holders who were born in China (inclusive of Hong Kong, Taiwan, and Macao) or once a Chinese citizen, have to provide <b>one</b> of the following documents: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Crossed-out Chinese passport (original and a photocopy of the front page).</li> <li>- Copy of each of your recent Chinese visas and a front page of the passport.</li> <li>- Copy of a birth certificate and a notarisation.</li> <li>- Copy of a crossed-out identity card or a registered residence booklet.</li> <li>- For applicants, who are former Chinese citizens and are applying for a Chinese visa for the first time, please provide the crossed-out Chinese passport (original and a photocopy of the front page).</li> </ul>
<input type="checkbox"/>	If you are applying for a Chinese visa for the first time, you should provide the last Chinese passport held and a photocopy of its data page.
<input type="checkbox"/>	An <b>invitation letter</b> issued by a Chinese citizen or a foreign citizen with a Chinese permanent residence permit who lives in China. The invitation letter should contain: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Information on the applicant (full name, gender, date of birth, etc.).</li> <li>- Information on the visit (purpose of visit, arrival and departure dates, place(s) to be visited, relations between the applicant and the inviting individual, financial source for expenditures).</li> </ul>

	- Information on the inviting individual (name, contact number, address, signature etc.).
<input type="checkbox"/>	Photocopy of <b>Chinese ID</b> or <b>foreign passport</b> and permanent residence permit of the inviting individual.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Applicants are required to provide photocopy of <b>certification</b> (marriage certificate, birth certificate or notarized certification of kinship) showing the relationship of family members between the applicants and inviting parties.
