## Tourist FDW Visa to China Checklist

- Once you filled in the online form, please, email it to us so we could make an appointment with the Chinese Visa Processing Centre.
- If you are aged between 14 and 70, you will have to submit fingerprints at the China Visa Application Service Centre unless you have already submitted your biometrics in the last 5 years and have not renewed your passport since. We will provide instructions upon submission.
- All documents should be printed or photocopied on A4-sized paper.
- Separate all the application documents for different applicants into individual sets.

DOCUMENTS:
Online visa application form completed, printed out and signed on first and last pages.
Original passport.
Colour copy of passport.
Copy of <b>Identity card</b> issued by Singapore Government (front and back).
Printout of the validity and expiry status of a pass from SGWorkPass app.
Printscreen from the helper's <b>SingPass</b> app showing employment status and name of employer.
Passport-size <b>photograph</b> in a digital format (for completing the online form) and on paper (for affixing to the printed out form)
Copy of employer's passport.
Copy of a passport and birth certificate of a <b>child</b> or an <b>elderly</b> who will be taken care of by the domestic helper.
Copy of employer's tickets.
Completed sponsorship/explanation letter.
Round-trip airline tickets.
Copy of a <b>hotel reservation</b> OR an <b>invitation letter</b> from a relevant entity or an individual located in China. The letter should contain detailed information about the applicant, information on the visit including dates of arrival and departure, places that will be visited, etc., and detailed information on the inviting party (with name, address, phone, official stamp, and signature).
Copy of passport of an inviting party if staying at a private address.
